

How Big is Anti-type?



















Revelation 21:22 And I saw no temple in the city, for its temple is the Lord God the Almighty and the Lamb. (speaking of heaven)

Revelation 1:1-3 (NKJV) The Revelation of Jesus Christ, which God gave Him to show His servants—things which must shortly take place. And He sent and signified it by

His angel to His servant John, 2 who bore

witness to the word of God, and to the testimony of Jesus Christ, to all things that he saw. 3 Blessed is he who reads and those who hear the words of this prophecy, and keep those things which are written in it; for the time *is* near.

Revelation 1:20 (NKJV)

The mystery of the seven stars which you saw in My right hand, and the seven golden lampstands: The seven stars are the angels of the seven churches, and the Seven lampstands which you saw are the seven churches.



From this picture we see Christ standing in the Holy Place surrounded by the 7 lampstands which are representative of the 7 churches in Asia Minor. (Anti-type in earths history)

Rev. 22:1 Then he showed me the river of the water of life, bright as crystal, flowing from the throne of God and of the Lamb. (The Sanctuary in heaven)

Revelation 6: 5 When He opened the third seal, I heard the third living creature say, "Come and see." So I looked and behold, a black horse, and he who sat on it had a pair of scales in his hand. And I heard a voice in the midst of the four living creatures saying, "A quart of wheat for a denarius, and three quarts of barley for a denarius; and do not harm the oil and the wine." (Spring, Summer & Fall feasts & Anti-type harvests of souls for Christ...Sanctuary feast anti-type still at work.)


Rev 16:5 + 15, "You are righteous, O Lord, The One who is and who was and who is to be... (the Lamb)

(white linen robes were worn by the priests)

Back to the Beginning


Jeremiah 17:12 "A glorious high throne from the beginning," was the place of His sanctuary

Genesis 3:8 And they heard the sound of the Lord God walking in the garden in the cool of the day and the man and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the Lord God...But the Lord God called to man, and said to him, "Where are you?"....

Exodus 25:8 "And let them make Me a sanctuary, that I may dwell among them.


The sacrificial offerings were ordained by God to be to man a perpetual reminder and a penitential acknowledgment of his sin and a confession of his faith in the promised Redeemer....To Adam, the offering of the first sacrifice was a most painful ceremony. His hand must be raised to take life, which only God could give. It was the first time he had ever witnessed death, and he knew that had he been obedient to God, there would have been no death of man or

beast. As he slew the innocent victim, he trembled at the thought that his sin must shed the blood of the spotless Lamb of God. This scene gave him a deeper and more vivid sense of the greatness of his transgression, which nothing but the death of God's dear Son could expiate. (PP 68) (The very first Passover)



As we have noticed, God presented the Sanctuary services in microcosm at Eden's gate to illustrate the plan of salvation to our first parents and their children. Thither Cain and Abel came to present their sacrifices and were followed by many of their descendants


for sixteen centuries. Just prior to the flood the Hand that had planted the Garden withdrew it from the earth. The Gardener of Galilee will one day restore it "more gloriously adorned than at the beginning" (PP 62 EGW)



Genesis 3:24 He drove out the man; and at the <u>east of the garden</u> of Eden he placed the cherubim, and a flaming sword which turned every way, to guard the way to the tree of life. (Garden gate faced east)

Genesis 4:3 In the course of time Cain brought to the Lord an offering of the fruits of the ground, and Abel brought of the <u>firstlings of his flock and of their fat portions.</u>

Leviticus 26:11,12 "I will set My Tabernacle among you,...and I will walk among you (Jesus our Lamb walked among us.)



"The plan of salvation had been laid before the creation of the earth; for Christ is "the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world" Revelation 13:8

(Patriarchs & Prophets 63)


Hebrews 8:4-5 Now if he were on earth, he would not be a priest at all, since there are priests who offer gifts according to the law. (Levites) They serve a copy and shadow of the heavenly sanctuary for when Moses was about to erect the tent, he was instructed by God

saying, "See that
you make everything
according to the pattern which was shown
you on the mountain




Exodus 40:6 You shall set the altar of burnt offerings before the door of the tabernacle of the

tent of meeting, and place the laver between the tent of meeting and the altar.. (The Priest must wash & be clean before entering the tent.)



Exodus 27:13 "The breadth of the court on the front to the <u>east</u> shall be fifty cubits."



Exodus 29:4 "You shall bring Aaron and his sons to the *door of the tent* of *meeting*, and wash them with water."

John 10:9 I am the door; if any one enters by me, he will be saved, and will go in and out and find pasture.

Isaiah 40:21,22 Have you not known? Have you not heard? Has it not been told you from the beginning? Have you not understood from the foundations of the earth? It is he who sits above the circle of the earth, and its inhabitants are like grass-hoppers; who stretches out the heavens like a curtain, and spreads them like a tent to dwell in;

Striking Similarities

- The Temple/Tent faced east
- •The Lamb was brought to the door of the tent (which faced east) to be slain
- •The Lamb was brought to the east gate of Eden to be slain
- •God's throne/sanctuary faces east and the river of life flows from it.
- A river flowed out of Eden
- A river flows from the temple
- A tree of life in Eden
- •A tree of life in heaven (Eden)
- God walked with Adam & Eve in Eden
- God met with Moses in the sanctuary tent
- •Only priests of the line of Aaron with the blood lambs could enter the tent.

 Conclusion

Heavenly Eden where God is enthroned then Eden the first "sanctuary" on earth, only the Heavenly Sanctuary exists thru the end of the world.
