





Exodus 12:5 Your lamb shall be without blemish, <u>a male a year old.</u> (Jesus Christ our lamb)


(Remember that 1 day only happens once in the year and represented the entire sanctuary round of feasts)






Revelation 7:10 And crying out with a loud voice, "Salvation belongs to our God who sits upon the throne, and to the Lamb!"








Genesis 22:7, 8 He said, "Behold, the fire and the wood; but where is the lamb for the burnt offering?' Abraham said, "God will provide Himself the Lamb for a burnt offering my son." So they went both of them together.

The Very 1st Covenant Adam to the Flood



Hosea 6:7 But at Adam they transgressed the covenant; there they dealt faithlessly with me.

Leviticus 23:15-21 "And you shall count from the morrow after the Sabbath, from the day that you brought the sheaf of the wave offering; seven full weeks shall they be, counting fifty days to the morrow after the seventh Sabbath; then you shall present a cereal offering of new grain to the Lord. You shall bring from your dwellings two loaves of bread to be waved, made of two tenths of an



ephah;they shall be <u>baked with leaven</u>, as <u>first fruits</u> to the Lord. And you shall present with the bread seven lambs <u>a year old without</u> <u>blemish</u>....you shall hold a holy convocation; you shall do no laborious work: it is a statute for ever in all your dwellings throughout your generations.

(With leaven= sin----no leaven = no sin)





Numbers 21:8 And the Lord said to Moses: "Make a fiery serpent, and set it on a pole: and every one who is bitten, when he sees it, shall live.


(With leaven= sin----no leaven = no sin)


Genealogies Adam to Flood 1657 years. (Just fits into time frame)




Genesis 8:13-20 In the six hundred and first year, in the <u>first month</u>, the <u>first day</u> of the month, the waters were dried from off the earth; and Noah removed the covering of the ark, and looked, and behold, the face and the ground was dry.(Nisan 1) In the <u>second month</u>, on <u>the twenty-seventh</u> day of the month, the earth was dry. (Ivyar) Then God said to Noah, "Go forth from the ark... 20 Then Noah built an



altar to the Lord, and took of every clean animal and of every clean bird, and offered burnt offerings on the altar. And the Lord smelled the pleasing odor... (Just in time for the Feast of Weeks/first fruits)



1 Peter 3:18-21 For Christ also died for sins once for all, the righteous for the unrighteous, that he might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh but made alive in the spirit; in which he went and preached to the spirits in prison, who formerly did not obey when God's patience waited in the days of Noah, during the building of the ark, in which a few that is, eight




persons, were saved through water. Baptism, which corresponds to this, now saves you, not as a removal of dirt from the body but as an appeal to God for a clear conscience, through the resurrection of Jesus Christ.

1 Corinthians 15:18-20 Then those also who have fallen asleep in Christ have perished. If for this life only we have hoped in Christ, we are of all men most to be pitied. But in fact Christ has been raised from the dead, the First Fruits of those who have fallen asleep. (See also Leviticus 23:15-17)

(Both Wave Sheaf/first fruits Nisan 16 & Feast of Weeks/50th day called First Fruits)




Adam, who was a type of the one who was to come.


The "Old" Covenant


(With leaven= sin----no leaven = no sin)






Exodus 19 & 20 the Law Given by Gods' Own Voice to the Israelite **Nation**

"Desire of Ages" pp. 756 When the loud cry, "It is finished," came from the lips of Christ, the priests were officiating in the temple. It was the hour of the evening sacrifice. The lamb representing Christ had been brought to be slain. Clothed in his significant and beautiful dress, the priest stood with lifted knife, as did Abraham when he was about to slay his son. With intense interest the people were looking on. But the earth trembles and quakes; for the Lord Himself draws near, With a rending noise the inner veil of the temple is torn from top to bottom by an unseen hand, throwing open to the gaze of the multitude a place once filled with the presence of God...But low, this veil is rent in twain. 





Tower of Babel =121 years after flood = 3.5 Years anti-type.








Daniel 9:24-27 (NKJV)" <u>Seventy weeks</u> are determined for your people and for your holy city, to finish the transgression, to make an end of sins, to make reconciliation for iniquity, to bring in ever-lasting righteousness, to seal up vision and Prophecy, and to anoint the Most Holy. 25 "Know therefore and understand, that from the going forth of the command to restore and build Jerusalem until Messiah the Prince, There shall be <u>seven weeks</u> and sixty-two weeks;.... 27 "Then he shall confirm a covenant with many for one week; <u>but in the middle of the week He shall bring and end to sacrifice and offering.</u> And on the wing of abominations shall be one who makes desolate, even until the consummation, which is determined, is poured out on the desolate."

The 7 weeks mentioned above have their reference in the Feast of Weeks/First Fruits


(7 weeks of Sabbaths to the 49th Sabbath and First Fruits on the 50th.)

Col 1:19 For it pleased the Father that in Him all the fullness should dwell,



Divide 1810 years by 33.898 = <u>53.4</u> anti-type

53.4: 53 days and .4 into the 14th of Nisan; .5 would = 6:00 am (1/2 of a day) & .1; the difference between .4 & .5 would = 2.40 hours. 6:00 am - 2.40 hours = 3.20 am in the garden





Galatians 3:10-14 For all who rely on works of the law are under a curse; for it is written, "Cursed be every one who does not abide by all things written in the book of the law, and do them." Now it is evident that no man is justified before God by the law; for "He who through faith is righteous shall live"; but the law does not rest on faith, for "He who does them shall live by them." Christ redeemed us from the curse of the law, having become a curse for us---that in Christ Jesus

the blessing of Abraham might come upon


the <u>Gentiles</u>, that we might receive the promise of the Spirit <u>through faith</u>.

(He perished so we don't have to)






Hebrews 8:4-10 Now if he were on earth, he would not be a priest at all, since there are priests who offer gifts according to the law. They serve a copy and shadow of the heavenly sanctuary; for when Moses was about to erect the tent, he was instructed by God, saying "see that you make everything




according to the pattern which was shown you on the mountain." But as it is, Christ has obtained a ministry which is as much more excellent than the old as the covenant he mediates is better, since it is enacted on better promises. (His "works" and not ours for by "faith" in Him are we saved)

For if that first covenant had been faultless, there would have been no occasion for a second. For he finds fault with them when he says: "The days will come, says the Lord when I will establish a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah; not like the covenant that I made with their fathers on the day when I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt; for they did not continue in my covenant, and so I paid no heed to them, says the Lord. This is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, says the Lord: I will put my laws into their minds, and write them on their hearts, and I will be their God and they shall be my people.



Romans 5:6 (NKJV) For when we were still without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly. (Anti-type fulfilled)

Galatians 4:4 But when the <u>fullness of</u>
<u>the time</u> had come, God sent forth His
Son, born of a woman, born under the
law, (Ceremonial Law/at the Appointed Time)



John 7:6-8 Then Jesus said to them, "My time has not yet come, but your time is always ready. ⁷ The world cannot hate you, but it hates Me because I testify of it that its works are evil. ⁸ You go up to this feast. I am not yet going up to this feast, for My time has not yet fully come."

Matt 5:17 "Do not think that I came to destroy the Law or the Prophets. I did not come to destroy but to fulfill. (Ceremonial law fulfilled in Jesus)
