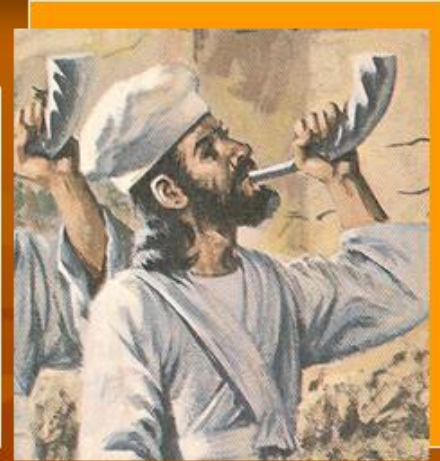


## *The Feast of Trumpets*

**Leviticus 23:23-26** And the Lord said to Moses, “Say to the people of Israel, in the seventh month on the first day of the month, you shall observe a day of solemn rest, a memorial proclaimed with blast of trumpets, a holy convocation. You shall do no laborious work; and you shall present an offering by fire to the Lord.”



The **feast of Trumpets** began 10 days prior to the **Day of Atonement**

$$10 \times 33.898 = 338.98 \text{ years}$$

$$1844 - 338.98 = 1505$$

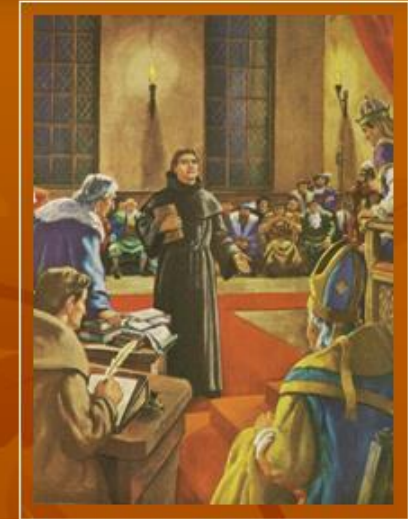

## Anti-type in History

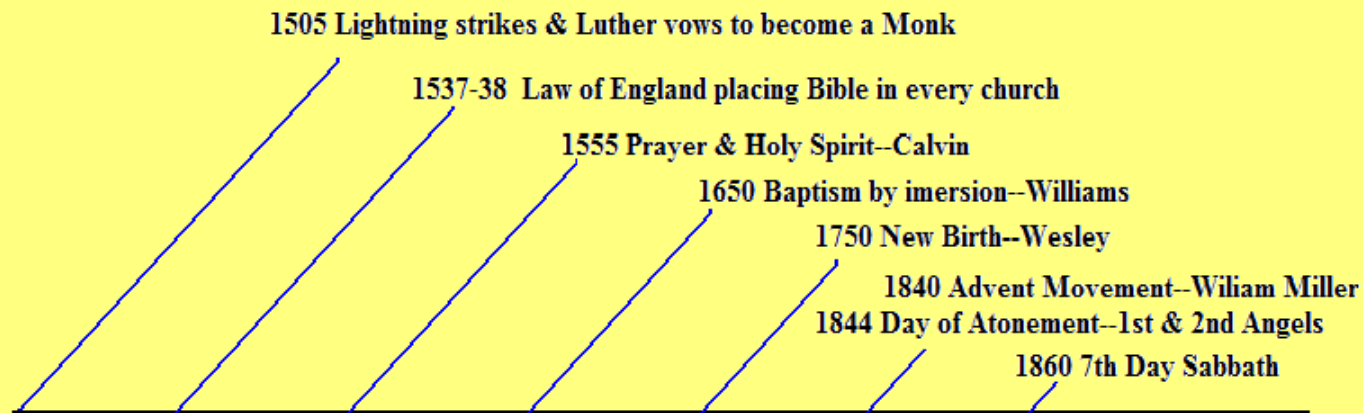


### Talk about a trumpet blast!

**Numbers 29:1-6** (the SDA Bible Commentary vol. 1 pp 805 v. 24  
Blowing the trumpets. On the first day of the seventh month was  
a Sabbath; “an holy convocation” was to be held. On that day the  
trumpets were blown, for the Day of Atonement was near at  
hand, and the first nine days of the month were to be days of  
preparation for it.



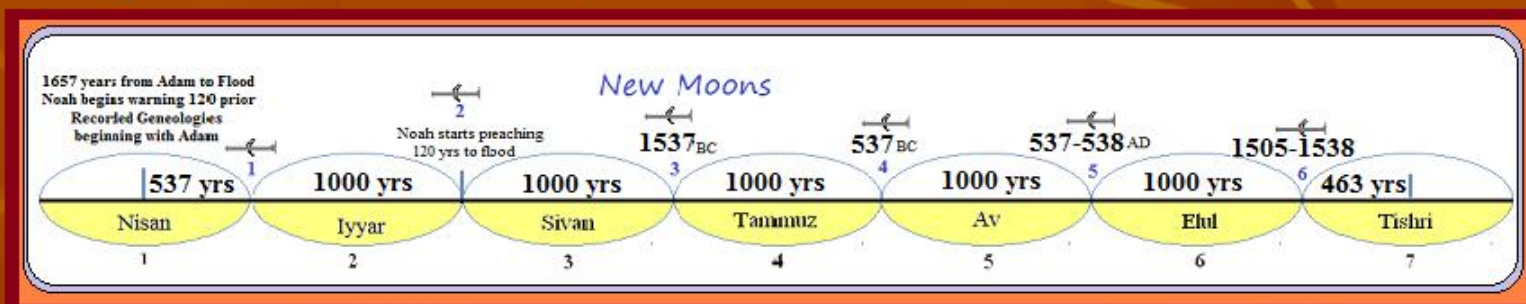
## Preparation for the *Great Day of Atonement*



**The Great Reformation was a preparation for the 1844 movement. It opened the door for the Bible to be preached as well as printed. It was a call to holiness and a turning away from the worldliness that prevailed Christendom. It was a time of preparation for the 1st and 2nd angels message..."The hour of judgment has come" The heavenly Day of Atonement proclaimed on earth.**

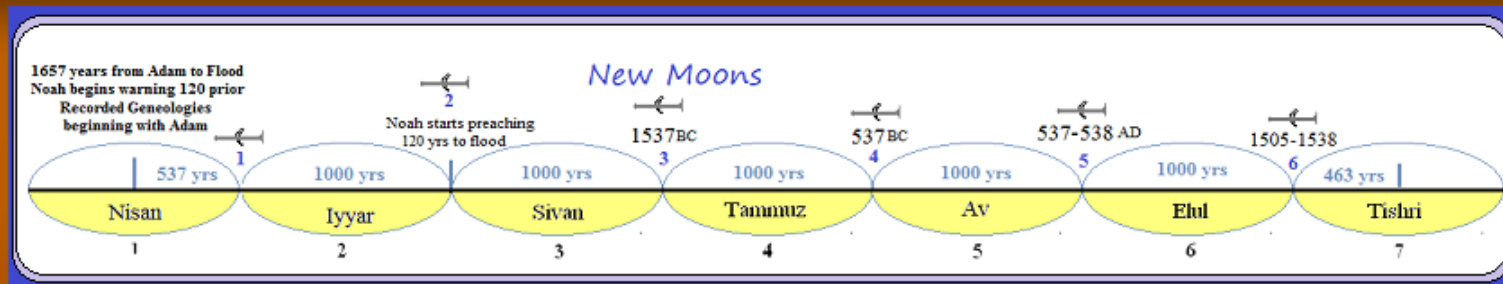
## The Monthly Trumpets

Psalms 81: 2 Raise a song, sound the timbrel, the sweet lyre with the harp. 3 Blow the trumpet at the new moon, at the full moon, on our feast day. (New moon was the first silver sliver seen, i.e. 1st of Nisan, and full moon was 14-15 days later Passover)



### #1 New Moon Trumpet

537 After Adam Jared 77 yrs old became the father of Enoch at 162 years. (463 years from the beginning of the month)



**#2 New Moon Trumpet 2604 B.C. (1067 yrs.) Also 1537 years from Adam & 120 years before the flood.**

**#3 New Moon Trumpet 1537 B.C. *Levitical Priests officiating Children of Israel should have* celebrated 1st Jubilee in land of Israel.**

**#4 New Moon Trumpet 537/38 B.C. *Cyrus called to be a trumpet blower/priest.* Is 44:24-28 Thus says the LORD, your Redeemer, who formed you from the womb: "I am the LORD, who made all things, who stretched out the heavens alone, who spread out the earth--Who was with me? -- 26 who confirms the word of his servant, and performs the counsel of his messengers; who says of Jerusalem, 'She shall be inhabited,' and of the cities of Judah, 'They shall be built, and I will raise up their ruins'; 27 who says to the deep, 'Be dry, I will dry up your rivers'; 28 **who says of Cyrus, 'He is my shepherd, and he shall fulfill all my purpose';****

**King Cyrus issues decree to let  
Children of Israel return to Homeland,  
is also a Jubilee year.  
537/538 BC**



**#5 New Moon Trumpet 537-538 A.D.**

**Three discarded horns from Daniel 7:24-25....The Papacy did away with Heruli in 493 A.D., the Vandals in 534 A.D. and the Ostrogoths in 538 A.D. (Heruli, under Odoacer, the Vandals, and the Ostrogoths" Horae Apocalypticae, Vol 3 pg. 134 note 1 by Edward B. Elliot, quoted in "Daniel and our Times" by R.J.Wieland pg. 96 Similarly said in Gibbons book "The Decline and Fall of the Roman Empire" chapter 41)**

**Pope Vigilius reigned as *pope* from 537 to 555, is considered the first pope of the *Byzantine Papacy*.**

(Vigilius was known to be one of the most evil men in history....you can look him up on the internet. He was a very corrupt individual.)

#6 1505-1537/38 Martin Luther  
Father of the Reformation called  
to be a *priest* June 1505
